Entry requirements

- Acceptance on the course will be by interview. Training Provider requires GCSE A-C English and Maths. Good communication skills would be an advantage as barbering involves talking to people of different ages and is a personal service.

Why choose this course?

Barbering involves the cutting and styling of men's hair. To become a barber you will need a unique combination of skills and require a great deal of training. You will need to be an excellent communicator with a high degree of physical stamina. You should be diplomatic, sympathetic and have the ability to listen and communicate. You will have to be prepared to undergo a long training period and continue learning for the rest of your working life.

Level 2 : Units:

- Advise and consult with clients
- Cut hair using basic barbering techniques
- Cut facial hair to shape using basic technique
- Dry and finish men's hair
- Shampoo, condition and treat the hair and scalp
- Create basic patterns in hair
- Fulfil salon reception duties
- Promote additional services or products to customers

Level 3 : Units:

- Provide shaving services
- Creatively cut hair using a range of barbering techniques
- Design and create patterns in hair
- Fulfil salon reception duties
- Colour and lighten men's hair

Possible career pathway

The course offers you a specialist work-based qualification to support a career as a Barber or to progress onto studying for an NVQ level 3 in Barbering. With further training and experience, you could go onto working as a senior Barber or with the relevant business knowledge you could also set up your own Barber shop.
